It is most suitable for those acting as the club child protection officer but is also relevant for those responsible for managing or organising the club

Many governing bodies of sport require each club to have a trained Child Protection Officer in place.

**Attendees must have attended a Safeguarding & Protecting Children workshop or equivalent**

#### ***What will I learn?***

This workshop will cover the Child Protection Policy and Procedures. It will examine the role of the Child Protection Officer in implementing the policy and ensuring other are aware of it and following best practice.

It will help develop an understanding of what to do in a range of situations that could occur within a club environment, where they can access support and other details. It also provides an opportunity to network with other club Child Protection Officers, ask questions and hear real life examples of how other clubs manage child protection.
